
...with comprehensive rehabilitation

Familiar faces and furnishings help our residents feel comfortable in their new home and neighborhood as they participate in therapeutic and enriching activities.

Our team of physicians and support staff in a variety of disciplines — including nursing, nutrition, social services, rehabilitation, pastoral care and activity specialists — work together to provide a safe and comfortable home environment where each resident is valued and appreciated.

The continuity of care and personal knowledge of each resident is an important benefit and instrumental in the person's ability to function normally. Regular assessments of the team determine the level of care that will be most beneficial to address residents' needs as they progress.
