

Thank you for considering volunteering here at Passavant Community. We appreciate the possibility of serving together and your help in providing the *Abundant Life*® to our residents. Below is a listing of current openings.

**Nursing Community Life (Activities)**

**Come and Listen** – Read stories to residents either 1:1 or in a small group. Times flexible

**Pianist/Organist/Instrumentalists** - Provide music on organ or piano for residents who just enjoy listening to music in their household. Days and times flexible

**One-on-One Visits**- Visitors for residents are always welcome. Visit, play games, read poetry, do puzzles, escort to destinations in the main building or outside during nice weather. Visit at times best for volunteer and resident; befriend one or more residents, prefer weekly visits.

**Small Group Activity Leader or Assistant**- Lead activities such as board games, baking, crafts, jewelry making, discussion groups, poetry or book groups, or active games such as Wii bowling or noddle ball. Days and times flexible.

**Hymn Sing/Sing-along Accompanist (Piano or organ)** - Accompany residents as they sing from song sheets. Music provided.

**Montessori Activities Assistant** – Assist Memory Care Nursing residents with Montessori based activities; days and times flexible. Training provided.

**Household Helper and Visitor** – Help residents by replenishing their ice water pitchers in their rooms and visit Wednesday and Saturday are best 11- 12:30 1:00

**Pet/Dog Visitors** - Best candidates for dogs and cats are those with background in obedience school training or therapy training, are 1 year old or older, and are spayed or neutered. Dogs must be able to obey simple commands (stay, sit, etc). Must have proof of insurance and current shot records for pets. Handler must be 15 or older or accompanied by adult. Handler must be sensitive to the elderly and their possible aversion to an animal and be able to manage interaction of pet with residents. Thursday afternoon. Other days and times may be available.

**Craft Facilitator or Assistant**- Lead or assist in leading a small group of residents in making crafts. Supplies provided. Patterns and ideas can be provided

**Manicurists**- Pamper our ladies with polish and light hand lotion massage. Cutting of nails not required. Sunday afternoon

**Men's Lunch Companion** – Escort our men from nursing to the Men's Lunch and befriend them as you share a meal and conversation. Once a month.

**Visitors** - Men to visit one on one with other men. Days and times are flexible

**Bowling** – Help prepare the game, reset pins as residents play and cheer them on! Wednesday afternoons

**Chapel Escort**- Pick your shift! Volunteer can select shift 9:45 - 10:30 taking residents to the chapel, 11:30-12:15 helping residents from the chapel to their dining room, or 9:45-12:15 taking the residents to and from the chapel plus visiting other residents here for rehab who remain in their rooms during the chapel service. Volunteers would serve every other Sunday. Volunteers must be able to push wheelchairs, be dependable and enjoy conversing with our rehab patients and our elders!

**Personal Care Community Life (Activities)**

**Pianist** – Play for hymn sings or singalongs or to just entertain; Wednesday, or Friday at 2:00

**Reminisce Group**- Using supplied materials to help stimulate minds and conversation, lead a group of residents as they talk about “the good old days”; Fri. at 10:00

**Memory Care Activity Assistant and Visitor**- Assist residents with Montessori materials such as matching cards, Memory books, reading in small groups or one on one. Training provided. Noon – 1:30 or 2:30-4:30 any Monday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. Previous experience with memory care helpful but not necessary

**Corn Hole Assistant** – These residents can play but need help setting up and putting away the game and picking up the bags during the game. Fridays 1:30 - 2:30

**Pet/Dog Visitors** - Best candidates for dogs and cats are those with background in obedience school training or therapy training, are 1 year old or older, and are spayed or neutered. Dogs must be able to obey simple commands (stay, sit, etc). Must have proof of insurance and current shot records for pets. Handler must be 15 or older or accompanied by adult. Handler must be sensitive to the elderly and their possible aversion to an animal and be able to manage interaction of pet with residents. Days and times flexible.

### **Newhaven Court Community Life (Activities)**

**One-on-One Visits**- visit at times best for volunteer and resident; befriend one or more residents, prefer weekly or twice a month visits

**Evening Activities Assistant**– Lead an activity or game Monday, Tuesday or Thursday evening at 6:30

**Craft Facilitator or Assistant**- Lead or assist in leading a small group of residents in making crafts. Supplies provided. Patterns and ideas can be provided. Tuesday or Wednesday, 1:30; once a month. If volunteer would like to be involved weekly, can assist with other activities.

**Pianist** - Singalongs; first Monday of the month; 3:00. Day can be flexible if needed

**Social Event/Activities Assistance** – Assist during the day with set up and serving for wine & cheese, birthday party bingo and cake, social (Mother's Day, Halloween, Easter Party, etc.); afternoons usually Monday, Tuesday or occasional Thursday

**Wii Bowling Leader** - Set up and assist residents as needed with the game. Prefer evening or 3:00 afternoon, any day except Friday.

**Pet visits** –Visit residents in the community room and lobby. Best candidates for dogs and cats are those with background in obedience school training or therapy training, are 1 year old or older, and are spayed or neutered. Dogs must be able to obey simple commands (stay, sit, etc). Must have proof of insurance and current shot records for pets. Handler must be 15 or older or accompanied by adult. Handler must be sensitive to the elderly and their possible aversion to an animal and be able to manage interaction of pet with residents. Days and times flexible (Wed. at 2:00 not available)

**Musicians**- Play baby grand in lobby or bring your own instrument to serenade residents as they come and go for lunch or dinner. Anytime between 11-2 or 4-6

**Men's Group**- Help lead a group of men for one afternoon a month to meet, chat and play games. Tuesday or Thursday afternoons are best times.

**Visitors**- Men to visit one on one with other men. Days and times are flexible

**Men's Night Out Escort/ Companion**- Escort men to the main building for an evening of refreshments and table games such as pool and shuffle board. Stay and play and escort them home again. First and third Monday evening at 5:00 pm in our Game Room.

### **Community Life/Independent Living**

**Program Presentations** - Have an idea, travel log or hobby you would like to present? Times flexible

**Wittenberg Place Special Event Assistant** - Assist with set up for events which includes setting tables, minimal food prep such as making coffee or mixing pancake batter and other pre-event needs. Serve food and beverages to residents. Assist with clean up after the event. Follow food safety and hand sanitization when handling food items. Socials are afternoons 1-4; Tea Parties: second Wednesday of every month 1-4; Pancake Breakfast: Thursday mornings every other month. Must be able to carry food and beverages, serve residents cheerfully, and follow direction of staff, and follow food safety guidelines and hand washing. Can select one or all events to assist

**Men's Coffee/ Bistro Boys** - Held in our Game Room or Bistro; host men from Residential Living, My Day Out and Personal Care; conversation, coffee and doughnuts; 10:00 any Tuesday – Friday , 2 times a month

**Men's Lunch** – Help coordinate, greet and host this luncheon once a month in the Baron's Inn for nursing, personal care and Independent living men. Can help set up speakers each month. Food will be coordinated by staff.

### **Other**

**Volunteer Greeter** – Provide a welcoming presence for Passavant's many visitors; Fridays 2-4; Saturday 10-12; Sundays 10-11

**Fitness Center Receptionist**- Assist fitness members with check in, provide information to inquiries, answer phones; Thursday and Friday from 9:00-12:00 and Mon, Tues, Thursday and Friday from 1:00-3:00

**Gift Shop Substitute or Buddy** – **Serve as a second clerk on shift or as a substitute.** Clerks provide a friendly atmosphere for shoppers, make sales using cash register, make change, assist patrons, and fill out paperwork as needed. Shifts are any Monday – Friday 10-1 or 1-4:30. Would train on several shifts with trainer before substituting. Must be 18 or older.

**My Day Out (Adult Day Care Center) Activity Assistant** - Assist with a variety of activities such as crafts, Wii bowling, card and board games, baking; provide one-on-one visits; assist with meal set up and serving; and escort to special events here on our campus. Any Monday through Friday, best times are 10-1 or 10-2. **PHYSICAL and BACKGROUND CHECKS REQUIRED.**
