After months of construction and preparation, the Advanced Care Center of Butler (ACC) greeted its first resident, a LIFE Butler County participant, on April 5.

The newly renovated 29-bed facility provides skilled nursing and rehabilitation services in partnership with Butler Health System to assist patients in successfully transitioning home after injury, surgery, or illness.

Looking ahead, the location will supply a comprehensive array of care to existing Living Independence for the Elderly (LIFE) participants as well as long-term and short-term services to the community at large.

“The staff is more than ready to begin providing quality care to the residents of our community,” said ACC Nursing Home Administrator, Tracy Beck.

“So many hands made this possible, and we would like to thank everyone for the hard work and dedication that helped us reach this exciting point in time.”

LUTHERAN SERVICE SOCIETY PIONEERS MEAL DELIVERY SERVICE FOR CAREGIVERS

Lutheran Service Society (LSS) has a proud tradition of serving neighbors in need.

In fact, the organization opened Pittsburgh's first Meals on Wheels kitchen in 1968.

Now, more than 50 years later, the nonprofit has pioneered another

foodservice initiative that extends to individuals who are busy caring for loved ones during the pandemic.

Volunteers began delivering convenient, affordable and healthy meals to caregivers, in addition to the program's regular client base, on March 1.

"We would typically consider someone eligible for Meals on Wheels if they lack the ability to grocery shop and cook for themselves," said LSS Administrator, Sarah Israel.

"Now we are seeing a need among people who are able to complete these tasks but are in danger

of falling into unhealthy eating patterns."

Program Manager Michael Dengel added, "Caregivers, by definition, are taking care of others. But we want to make it easier for them to take care of themselves as well."

The caregiver meal service is available to residents who live in, and around, Beaver County and there are no age or income requirements to enroll.

LIFE SPEARHEADS NATIONAL NUTRITION MONTH PROGRAMMING

Each March, our Living Independence for the Elderly (LIFE) nutritional services teams go above and beyond to educate seniors about the importance of making informed food choices in honor of National Nutrition Month.

This spring was no different, with staff rising to the occasion of spreading awareness in the midst of COVID-19.

Aside from nutrition-based educational opportunities, staff took on a food distribution project with Crossroads Church which supplied USDA Farmers to Families packages to seniors in need.

Each box contained fresh food, meats, dairy and produce.

“I cannot express how great our staff were with this project,” said LIFE Director of Nutritional Services, Darla Evans.

“Their dedication was unbelievable, and they immediately rose to the challenge of this initiative.”

The program called for LIFE dietitians to drive to Crossroads’ North Fayette and Cranberry locations and pick up 30 lb. boxes of food.

From there, the staff brought the food back to the LIFE centers and coordinated with transportation to deliver the boxes to each participant’s home.

“They ended up distributing more than 200 boxes by the end of March,” Evans said.

“We received so many phone calls thanking us because it was something that our participants appreciated.”

Prior to this initiative, when the LIFE centers first closed due to safety concerns associated with COVID-19, staff took on a similar project with frozen meals – except these numbers looked much different.

All in all, more than 10,000 meals were delivered to participants within the first month of the pandemic alone.

Thank you to our entire LIFE team for taking on the challenges associated with nutritional education and food insecurity throughout COVID-19. ❖

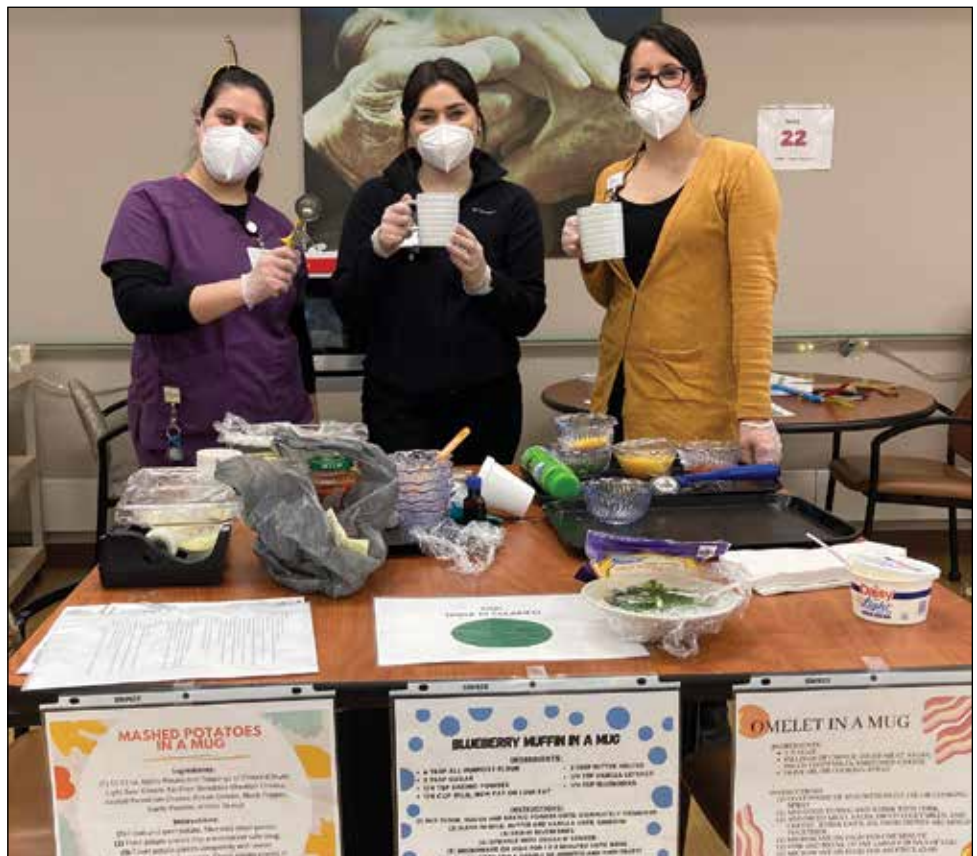
Living Independence for the Elderly (LIFE) is a nursing home alternative that allows seniors to live safely at home by providing them with access to a full range of medical, recreational and social services.

The HUR equipment, specifically designed for older adults, will permit more effective training with less risk of injury and foster an **Abundant Life**® for our residents at Lutheran SeniorLife's Passavant Community.

In addition, the equipment will feature HUR SmartTouch.

This system drives more participation among older adult users and offers an effective way for our wellness teams to monitor resident outcomes.

"The air resistance technology is going to make it so much easier on our resident's joints when they sit down to use the machines," said Passavant Community's Wellness Manager, Brian Damaska.

Sometimes, walking into the gym can be intimidating, especially if you've never worked out before, Damaska said.

"So, once the residents see that you can just scan a wrist band and the machine will automatically personalize the settings for you, I think it's going to make it way less overwhelming and inspire them to try something new."

The donated equipment comes at a perfect time as the community plans to launch its new approach to holistic wellness in June.

"It's an approach to getting older that allows you to grow and live an **Abundant Life**®," Damaska said. "I'm excited to give our residents hope and show that the game isn't over; we're just getting started."

PASSAVANT CELLIST SHARES HER PITTSBURGH SYMPHONY CAREER

Born and raised in Flint, Michigan, Charlotta Ross grew up playing the cello with hopes of performing in a symphony orchestra one day.

Little did she know, this dream would come true, along with many other chances to give back and share her extraordinary talents at Lutheran SeniorLife's Passavant Community campus.

As the daughter of a minister and piano teacher, Charlotta was surrounded by music from an early age.

And after she grasped the piano at 12 years old, Charlotta was eager to learn how to play the violin from her Jr. High School instructor.

However, life had different plans.

"My teacher already had 24 students playing the violin but no one playing the cello," Charlotta said.

"So my mother said I could try it for a semester."

That's all the time it took for Charlotta to fall in love with the large string instrument.

So much so, that Charlotta's mother bought her two cellos –one to play at home and another to play at school.

Back then, it cost \$2 for students to rent an instrument for the year.

A price, Charlotta says, would be unheard of today.

"So at that point, the cello chose me, and I just had to do it," Charlotta said.

From there, community donations from her hometown allowed Charlotta to spend her summers at Interlochen Center for the Arts and Michigan State University until she earned a scholarship to study the cello.

After college, she performed as a cellist in the North Carolina and Dallas Symphony Orchestras before moving to Pittsburgh to pursue a master's degree at Carnegie Mellon University.

"I didn't know it at the time, but I would soon marry a man that went to Carnegie Mellon too," Charlotta said.

That man was Paul Ross, the first African American to be awarded a full-time contract with the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra (PSO).

The two would go on to travel the world, raise three daughters and spend more than four decades performing together in the PSO.

In addition, this union included 12 years spent as dedicated volunteer conductors for children at Three Rivers Symphonette until Charlotta retired in 2012.

Approximately 500 people auditioned for a chance to take Charlotta's spot once she stepped offstage.

Today, Charlotta shares her talents with us at Passavant Community during various campus events and performances.

"Music brings me joy, and Passavant brings people together," Charlotta said. "Those are the parts that make me so happy to live here."
