VISITOR PROTOCOLS
(Effective November 1, 2022)

We are pleased that the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has lifted any restrictions on visitation and therefore, all visitors are welcome. We would appreciate cooperation with the following guidelines in an effort to continue to ensure the safety of our community.

- Visitors who have experienced any of the following should defer their visit until it is safe to do so:
 - A positive viral test for SARS-CoV-2 in the last 10 days;
 - Symptoms of COVID-19; or
 - Close contact with someone with SARS-CoV-2 infection or a high risk exposure (such as contact with someone who is positive in the home) in the last 10 days.
- Visitors must perform hand hygiene via hand washing or available hand sanitizer upon arrival to the facility and frequently during their visit.
- Visitors are no longer required to screen in (i.e. answer COVID questions or take their temperature) upon entry into the facility. However, visitors should continue to use the Kiosks to sign in and apply the visitor badge while in the Abundant Life Center.
- Visitors should note postings on the door and other prominent places that describe any requirements or recommended actions based upon any COVID activity taking place in the facility. We appreciate your cooperation with those postings and recommended actions.
- When the County Transmission rates, monitored by the facility weekly, drops below HIGH, visitors will not be required to mask during visitation but can choose to wear a mask should they so desire. Signs will be posted on the door and in prominent locations to alert visitors to any masking requirement based upon the Transmission rate.
- Masks will be required when the County Transmission rate is HIGH or there is a newly documented COVID infection within the facility. Postings on the door and in prominent locations will instruct visitors of the requirement so we appreciate your full cooperation with those postings when they are present.
- If the facility is experiencing a COVID outbreak, Passavant reserves the right to restrict visitation to certain areas (i.e. the Resident's room).
