Visitor Protocols

- Visitation can be conducted through different means and resident's needs such as in resident rooms, dedicated visitation spaces and outdoors.
- Visitors will not be required to mask during visitation when the County Transmission rates, monitored by the Facility weekly, drops below HIGH, also noted to be below 10% transmission rate. Masking will be required should the Facility have a newly documented infection within the facility.
- Visitors may choose to wear a mask for their comfort.
- Visitors will not be required to screen upon entry to the Facility. Visitors should note the postings at the door and other prominent places that describe any symptoms or issues that would need to be reported to the Facility prior to any visit.
- Visitors with any of the following criteria should notify the Facility prior to visitation:
 - A positive viral test for SARS-CoV-2
 - Symptoms of COVID-19; or
 - Close contact with someone with SARS-CoV-2 infection or a high risk exposure (such as contact with someone who is positive in the home).
- Visitors must perform hand hygiene via hand washing or available hand sanitizer.
- There is no limit on visitation by CMS at this time.
